On Wednesday, May 4, 2016 Charley and Diane Monaghan, representing the Emmaus Ministry for Grieving Parents, gave a presentation at the Archdiocese of Boston's "Traumatic Loss Workshop" at the Pastoral Center in Braintree, MA.

Their talk focused on what it is like to experience the death of a child by suicide and how the Emmaus Ministry serves the spiritual needs of parents whose children of any age have died by any cause, no matter how long ago. More than 100 people attended. Many expressed interest in encouraging members of their parish to attend Emmaus Ministry retreats. Several expressed interest in introducing the ministry in their parishes by offering retreats.
