COME, HOLY SPIRIT! PENTECOST, 2021

At Emmaus Ministry Retreats, if you are open...

Participating in either a physical or a virtual Emmaus Ministry retreat means entering into the realm of the Holy Spirit.

What takes place at these retreats has nothing to do with the people involved or preparations made, but everything to do with the Holy Spirit who is at work and in charge.

Through Him at these retreats, we encounter our God; we encounter our children; and we encounter where we are in our spiritual journey.

In this Saturday Morning Remote Retreat, we again invoke the Holy Spirit to be among us, to help us in our pain, and to empower us to feel the presence of our children this day.

Preparation:

Ahead of time, we recommend you find a quiet place in your home where you can immerse yourself in this retreat. Have your child's Emmaus Memorial Candle (or other candle) available along with a lighter or matches.

Take several deep breaths to cleanse your thoughts and open yourself to wherever the Holy Spirit is calling you today several minutes before the retreat is scheduled to begin.

At 9:30am EDT (our normal retreat beginning time) open your email and join other fellow Emmaus Parent Companions in getting away from the rest of the world, at least for a time, to focus on God and on your precious child.

CANDLE LIGHTING PRAYER (Light your candle)

We begin... In the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, Amen

Lord, you are the Light of the World. Help us feel your presence in the lighting of this candle.

Lord, you gave us the gift of our children. Help us feel their presence in the lighting of this candle.

Lord, you gave us the hope of eternal life. Help us confirm that hope in the lighting of this candle.

Lord, you gave us love. *Help us to know that, as much as we love our children, you love them even more.*

We ask you this through Christ, Our Lord Amen.

SCRIPTURE READING

Acts 2:1-11

When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were.

Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim.

Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven staying in Jerusalem. At this sound, they gathered in a large crowd, but they were confused because each one heard them speaking in his own language.

Draw my heart, O Holy Spirit, That I love but what is holy.

Strengthen me, O Holy Spirit, To defend all that is holy.
